

# From Chickadee Trailhead (Start/Finish)

## Thompson Aid Station

(VERY LIMITED PARKING)

Crew Access OK for 100k/50m/50k; Not advised for 25k

Turn Left out of the Chickadee Trailhead onto Thompson Ridge Rd (aka FS RD 4410). It's a dirt road with cattle guards. The aid station will be on your left at large grassy pull-off where the Meadowlark Trail meets the road. This is 0.6 miles after the 2nd cattle guard and 3.8 miles from Chickadee Trailhead. Very limited parking, and please drive slowly, so as to not stir up dust for the aid station volunteers/runners. And please drive past the aid station and park on the shoulder of the road, please don't park on the road before the aid station or at the aid station itself.

## Homestead Aid Station

(LIMITED PARKING)

Crew Access OK for 100k/50m/50k

Turn Left out of the Chickadee Trailhead onto Thompson Ridge Rd (aka FS RD 4410). In 0.2 mile turn Right onto Little Wolf Creek Rd. 0.1 from second cattle guard and 1.6 from Thompson Ridge Rd. Park on Little Wolf Creek Rd then walk through the gate on the right hand side, the aid station is about 50 meters past the gate at the intersection of the Homestead and Yellowjacket trails. Limited parking, and please drive slowly and courteously on Little Wolf Creek Rd. as runners will be running on this road. Please consider walking to the ~1 mile to the aid station via the Yellowjacket Trail from Chickadee it's pretty flat and pleasant.

## Patterson Lake Aid Station

(NO PARKING)

Crew access OK, BUT NO PARKING FOR CREWS/SPECTATORS (50m/50k) THERE IS NO DRIVING TO & NO PARKING AT THIS AID STATION LOCATION.

Only volunteers and race staff will be able to drive to/from this aid station location. But crews and spectators can walk about 1.5 miles to the aid station from the start/finish at Chickadee by heading out from the start and following the course to the Patterson Lake trail junction, at which point you'll take a LEFT to continue on Cabin Trail past the Patterson Cabins, and cross

Patterson Lake Road and then follow the Wintrop Trail downhill for about ½ a mile to the aid station.
